WALK WITH GOD VERSES

Romans 6:4 been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too **walk in newness of life.**

Romans 8:4 **do not walk** according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

2 Cor. 5:7 for we **walk by faith**, not by sight—

2 Cor. 6:16 God said, "I will dwell in them and **WALK AMONG THEM;** be their God, & they shall be My people.

Galatians 5:16 **walk by the Spirit**, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.

Ephes. 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would **walk in them.**

Ephes. 4:1 implore you to **walk** in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called,

Ephes. 4:17 **walk no longer** just as the Gentiles also walk,

Ephes. 5:2 **walk in love**, just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma.

Ephes. 5:8 were formerly darkness, but now you are Light in the Lord; **walk as children of Light**

Col. 1:10 **walk in a manner worthy of the Lord**, to please Him in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

Col. 2:6 as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, **so walk in Him,**

1 Thes. 4:1 as you received from us **instruction** as to how you **ought to walk** and please God (just as you actually do walk), that you excel still more.

1 John 1:6-7 If we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth; but if we **walk in the Light** as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

1 John 2:6 the one who says he abides in Him ought himself **to walk in the same manner as He walked.**

2 John 1:6 this is love, that we **walk according to His commandments.**

Rev. 3:4 in Sardis who have not soiled their garments; and they **will walk with Me in white**, for they are worthy.

Rev. 21:24 (HEAVEN) The nations will **walk by its light**, and the kings of the earth will bring their glory into it.

Intro:

- Chapter 11 – What is God going to do about the nations?
 - 12:1-3 is Abram’s second calling – (see Acts 7:1-2)
 - Terah (Abram’s father)– worshipper of many gods (Joshua 24:2)
- I. Abraham was sure of God’s calling (not all the details) 12:1-3
- Sometimes this is personal.
 - God’s Goals are different than our desires (wishes)

Five sure goals God has for us:

1. Be saved 1 Timothy 2:3-4,
2. Be Spirit-filled Colossians 3:16

1. What do you think would most improve your walk with Christ right now?
2. In what specific ways have you seen your walk with Christ improve this year?

1. Read Genesis 11 and 12 out loud. What stands out to you?

III. Growing deeper

2. Discuss the difference between goals and desires. What are the advantages of living by God given goals? What are the dangers of living by our desires (wishes) even if they are good desires?
3. Read John 10:1-6. What is the prerequisite for knowing God's will? ~ Who follows Christ's will? Who does not follow (Obey) the Lord?
4. Read Matthew 5:13-16. What should every believer joyfully expect and why?
5. Pray for one another that your walk with Christ would go deeper.
